Parks and Recreation Update: RDM Ard updated the Commission on the Flynn Circus, Aquamaids, the Art Walk, the new website, July 4th celebration, Administrative Secretary position, Public Works Director new hire, Maintenance Worker new hire, New Administrative Services Director (Tony McFarlene), Classes, and IPWD's last day.

Regular Agenda:

- 1. Additional Gazebo at SkyPark:** RDM Ard discussed the location, size, purpose, and cost of the proposed new structure. M/S: Sanguinetti/Seib to support the construction of a 20 ft. gazebo and tables in SkyPark in the location discussed and to support the relocation of the current table and BBQ. Carried: 3/0
- 2. Glenwood Open Space Update:** RDM Ard informed the Commission that the City has received the State grant that will fund the complete trail construction, parking improvements, and the Glenwood Drive road and bicycle improvements from the high school to the city limits. The trail building on the west side is making progress. The projected finish date is the end of July. Some of the areas were hard to work on due to the shale composition which required difficult hand work. So far, there has been great community support. There are volunteer opportunities every week through Mountain Bikers of Santa Cruz County (MBOSC). Construction on the East Side trails will begin in late fall of 2018. The planning process and the bridge design is currently in progress. K-Street improvement plans are near completion. K-Street will be widened to provide up to seven parking spots including ADA. Improvements will include new fencing and a gate.
- 3. Possible 5k race at Glenwood Preserve:** We need to have a process in place to have events on the Glenwood Trails. Trails used in the races need to be cleaned up and marked. The Glenwood Preserve trails will not be ready for the race. The time
