  - By having pavers around the base, it will give artists clean ways to anchor their art piece.
  - There's the ability to do very large art pieces.
  - The Arts Commission would be responsible for selecting art for the display.
  - If art is sold, Arts Commission could get a percentage of the profit.
  - Corbett will want final approval.
  - Artist will be responsible for insuring the art piece.

2. Arts Council of Santa Cruz County Grant Update: Commissioner McEwan reported that Melinda received a new foster child so grant will not be completed.
3. Art Walk Update: Reg Kittrelle made a presentation of a general plan, in draft form, for the Art Walk.
- The plan works with a close relationship with the business community in Scotts Valley i.e. location for art, sponsor an artist etc.
