SUBJECT: **MacDorsa Park Playground Design Review**

SUMMARY OF ISSUE

Recreation Division Manager Ard, updated the Parks and Recreation Commission at their March meeting regarding a grant received from Miracle Recreation Equipment Company for help with costs of replacing the play structure at MacDorsa Park. The grant application was accepted and an initial proposed design was put forth for the Commissioners to review along with financial cost.

The Commissioners discussed the proposal for 'rocks and ropes elements' however, felt it best to get public input since the two proposed designs are a very different style of equipment than what currently exists at MacDorsa Park.

FISCAL IMPACT

\$50,000.00 from Park DIF approved in the City's 2016/17 budget year.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Review MacDorsa Park Playground Design for approval to move to Council.





Existing Park






Reverse View



Plan View



SUMMARY OF ISSUE

A BIG thank you to the City's maintenance crew for all their hard work making our parks look even more amazing by tackling the following projects:

- An aggressive maintenance plan at Skypark consisting of top soil, aerating, gopher maintenance, mowing, and install of a new fertilization program.
- Siltanen Park retaining wall and painting of the BBQ/snack bar area.

The Scotts Valley Advocates has decided since this year is the City's 50th Birthday Celebration, to go bigger on the fireworks show.
