## Focus on the Volunteer ~ Geri Gibson

As the youngest child and only daughter of a Texan and a Californian who met in San Francisco, Geri Gibson always held her own against her beloved three older brothers. She acknowledges that she and her siblings were blessed to experience an idyllic childhood growing up in the small coastal town of San Luis Obispo (SLO). At that time, the city's population was only 14K and it was quite rural. Her father was the city's Postmaster for over 30 years; her mother a country school teacher in a nearby town (whose school is now a historic landmark). Over time, one by one, Geri's brothers were sent off to Ojai to boarding school and she in turn, was sent to Notre Dame College in Belmont. Upon her return to SLO, Geri worked for the US Army for a brief time as a part-time clerk until she took a job with the State of California in a department that was to become known as Cal-Trans!

Geri's love for cooking initially started from watching her father cook delicious meals for the family. After her marriage, Geri moved across the country to New Jersey for her husband's brief stint in the Army during the Korean War. Shortly upon moving back to SLO (so that her husband could finish his degree), they moved north to the Bay area by Walnut Creek and Lafayette.

Comfortable in her role as homemaker, she continued to experiment cooking with different types of foods, cuisines, and techniques. In between running a home, raising her children and working for Contra Costa County (CCC), Geri



took some Chinese cooking lessons. She enjoyed them so much, that this translated into her offering a series of Chinese cooking lessons in her home and that in turn, led to her becoming a caterer.

After retiring from CCC, it did not take Geri long to decide to move to Scotts Valley to be near some of her children and in no time at all, she started working for Santa Cruz County. After her "second" retirement and because she always wanted to be kept busy, she turned to her love of cooking in the multitude of jobs she next pursued: Farmer's Exchange, Chef Works, the Café in SV Book Store and From the Heart, to name but a few. In addition, delivered regularly to Positively Front Street, you would find Geri's decadent Chocolate Beet Cake!

Nowadays, accompanied by her constant companion, Ella - a standard poodle (a retired show dog), Geri is still very busy. At SVSC, she is the Meals on Wheels On-Site Admin, volunteers with dinners and events, mans the reception desk, cooks specialty dishes...and more. In addition, she keeps busy with water exercise, reading and keeping in touch with former co-workers with monthly luncheons. This proud mother of five children, seven grand-children and most recently, a first-time Great-Grandmother of three month old Andrew, makes time to visit them all locally here, in Walnut Creek and in the beautiful state of Oregon. She regularly shows up with her cheese bread which is a firm family favorite and has made sure the next generation knows how to make it too.
