Safety Reminders for Phone, Internet and Your Health

Tips for your Home Phone:

You need to register your phone number in the "Do Not Call Registry". If you have the internet available you can go to my website www.fbergholz.com and select the Do Not Call Me List selection. It is at the top of the left hand column. You will need to have an e-mail address to use this service. If you do not have the internet or an e-mail address, you can call 1-888-382-1222 to register your phone numbers. This will put you on the government list that stops most annoying phone calls. It does take about a month to activate so do it as soon as possible.

Please, please, please Do Not do what my mother used to do. When she got an unwanted call she would tell them "I am a 90 year old women living alone and I do not want your service". It took me a long time to get her to just hang up the phone. It is very dangerous to give them any information about yourself.

Tips for your Cell Phone:

Use the Do Not Call List above to register your Cell Phone also.

If you get a call that no one speaks after you answer the call, hang up and Do Not call that number back. There is a scam out there that charges you \$5 to \$10 on your phone bill for just calling back a number. Only call back numbers that you know. If someone wants to talk to you, they will call again.

Tips for your computer:






