NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Project Title: Gateway South Retail Store
Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (FSEIR)

Specific Project Location: The 17.62-acre project site is located on the west side of State Route 17, on La Madrona Drive, generally southwest of the Mt. Hermon Road/La Madrona Drive exit.

Description of Project: Consideration of a Planning Commission recommendation to the City Council to certify as adequate a Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (FSEIR) for the proposed Gateway South Retail Store. The project consists of a 143,000-square foot retail store and 517 associated parking spaces, including a 57,650 square foot parking deck. The elevated western portion of the site, which contains mature redwood and native live oak trees, would be retained as open space. The proposed project includes an amendment to the Gateway South Specific Plan to accommodate the proposed building coverage. Separate public hearings will be scheduled for planning development permits

Potential Environmental Impacts Eight significant, unavoidable impacts have been identified related to traffic and transportation. Some potentially significant impacts were identified related to aesthetics, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, hydrology/water quality, noise, and public services. Each of these non-transportation impacts would be mitigated to a less than significant level if the identified mitigation measures are implemented. With the implementation of the mitigation measures and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program all but the eight significant and unavoidable impacts will be less than significant.


