Project Location: No situs (address); parcel is accessed past the existing cul-de-sac of Santa's Village Road, north of Granite Creek Road, Scotts Valley, CA 95066; Assessor Parcel Number: 024-031-17

Description of Project: Consideration of City Council review of Planning Commission recommendation to approve Final Environmental Impact Report, General Plan Amendment, Zone Change, Planned Development Overlays & Permits, Land Division, Use Permits, Design Reviews, and Cultural Resource Alteration and to adopt a Statement of Overriding Considerations for significant and unavoidable environmental impacts for construction of 50 townhouse-style condominiums on approximately 4.32 acres, a 120-room hotel on 2.48 acres, plus access roads and related property improvements. The 3- & 4-bedroom condominiums would be 3-story buildings of approximately 1,700 square feet in living area plus a 2-car garage. The hotel would operate under a select-service, extended-stay model and be a four-story complex, approximately 87,000 square feet of floor area. The proposed projects would be constructed separately.

The application is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines. The Draft and Final EIRs have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as set forth in the Public Resources Code, Sections 21000 et seq., as amended.

Environmental Effects Analyzed: The Draft EIR identified significant or potentially significant effects associated with: aesthetics, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology & soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hydrology & water quality, land use & planning, noise & vibration, public services, utility & service systems, and transportation & circulation. With the implementation of recommended mitigation measures, all impacts would be reduced to less than significant levels with the exception of transportation & circulation, which would remain significant and unavoidable due to existing traffic conditions.
