Notice of Public Hearings for Proposed Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance

Project Title: Commercial Medical Marijuana - Section 17.60

Planning Permits: Zoning Ordinance Amendments AZO15-005

Project Location: City-wide in all zones

Description of Project: AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTS VALLEY ADDING CHAPTER 17.60 TO THE SCOTTS VALLEY MUNICIPAL CODE PROHIBITING ALL COMMERCIAL MEDICAL MARIJUANA USES IN THE CITY AND PROHIBITING CULTIVATION FOR MEDICAL USE BY A QUALIFIED PATIENT OR PRIMARY CAREGIVER AND REPEALING CHAPTER 17.58 RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES

The proposed amendments are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), per CEQA Guidelines Section 15305, Class 5, Minor Alterations to Land Use Limitations and Section 15061(b)(3), general rule that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential to cause a significant effect on the environment. Planning Commission will review the amendments and make a recommendation to City Council.
