Our program is designed to provide a safe, caring environment in a large and/or small group recreational setting. Children are encouraged to develop social, creative, physical, and play skills through a variety of structured and unstructured activities. Our program is licensed by the State of California.

Registration

All registration is completed at the Recreation Division Office at Skypark, 361 Kings Village Road, Scotts Valley. To enroll, families complete a registration packet for each child and make payment for the first month's tuition. Families may choose part-time or full-time participation in each program, or sign up for our Drop-In or Wednesday Only options.

Programs

Before School

Hours: 7:00-8:15am
Grades: Kindergarten—Fifth
Description: Each morning , activities such as arts & crafts and games are set up for the children as they arrive.
To Bring: Children may bring their own breakfast or make arrangements with the school for a breakfast to eat at Rec.

Kinder Kamp

Hours: Brook Knoll KinderKamp AM: 8:00-11:45am
KinderKamp PM: 11:45am-3:00pm
Vine Hill 8:00-9:10 am AND 11:30am-3:00pm

Grades: Kindergarten only
Description: The children's daily schedule will include games, arts &

AfterSchool

- Hours: 2:20-6:00pm—Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays & Fridays
12:20-6:00pm—Wednesdays
- Grades: Kindergarten –Eighth
- Description: Each afternoon is structured with age group rotations (K/1, 2/3, 4/5, 6-8th) and free time. Activities include arts & crafts, games, “Art with Angie” time, special events, “Reading is Delicious”, and optional homework club.
- To Bring: Backpack/bag for your child’s belongings and a lunch on minimum days (Wednesdays), or make arrangements with the school for your child to receive a bag lunch. A daily snack is provided.
- **New this year**, to enrich your child’s After-School hours, we will provide transportation to other Recreation Division classes such as Chess Wizards, Clay for Kids, Playwell Technology and others. Ask us for the details!

Winter/Spring Camp and No School Rec Days

- Hours: 7:00am-6:00pm
- Grades: Kindergarten—Eighth
- Description: A full day of activities for all age groups. Separate registration required.
- To Bring: A lunch for each day. Daily snacks are provided!

Drop In or Wednesday Only

We also offer Drop In and Wednesday Only Care programs for families that need limited care. Activities and what children should bring are same as descriptions above.

- Drop In:** \$50.00 enrollment fee per child for the year.
Charged a daily fee for Before School, KinderKamp and After School attendance. Limited to 4 uses in a month.
- Wednesday Only:** Vine Hill 12:20-3:00pm
Brook Knoll 12:20-3:15pm
(If you need care past 3:00/3:15, please choose Drop-In or part-time program)

Our program is licensed by the State of California. As such, an authorized representative from the Department of Social Services Community Care Licensing Division can inspect our facilities and interview staff and/or children without prior authorization.

Most frequently asked questions...

Who are the staff?

All staff members meet State Licensing requirements and are supervised by a full-time permanent Site Director. Many have earned, or are working on, college degrees in related fields. All are passionate about sharing their talents with your child in a recreation setting!

How do I know my child will be safe?

The City of Scotts Valley believes children's safety is the number one priority. Our programs are licensed by the State of California as a school-age daycare and children are supervised at all times. No child will be picked up from the program without proper written consent from an authorized parent/guardian. The staff check ID, so please bring your driver's license with you when picking up.

How much do the programs cost?

Every month is different depending on the number of days care is open, whether you need full-time or part-time care and if you are a resident of Scotts Valley.

What do you mean by "program"?

Our school day is broken into specific time blocks, or programs: Before School, Kinder Kamp and After School. Hours allowed for one program may not be used in another program.

Are there any other programs options?

Yes! Families who need only limited care may want to consider enrolling in our Drop-In, Wednesday Only, Winter/Spring Camp and/or One Day Rec programs. See inside brochure for details, or call Recreation Division Office (831) 438-3251
