Project Description: Consideration of Variance Amendment and Design Review Amendment, to request 9-months to build a previously approved debris flow wall (120-feet long x 8-feet high x 10-inches wide) for hillside protective infrastructure, and possibly a reduced-size pool deck expansion (about 1,100 square feet), and a reduced-size pool retaining walls, all subject to the previously approved project plans, mitigation measures, and conditions of approval.
Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Planning Commission approve the extension, subject to amended conditions and mitigation measures.
