CONTENTS

- , location and description of the study area, including:
 - a) site address
 - b) size of parcel (expressed in acres or square feet)
 - c) a description of the area included in the surface reconnaissance (e.g. western half of parcel, entire parcel, area within 30 feet of the proposed homesite)
 - d) Universal Transverse Mercator Grid center point of the project area
 - e) elevation or elevation range of the study area
 - f) indication of nearest source of water
- ! a brief description of the proposed project including the amount of grading (cut and fill), depth of cut and fill
- ! file number for the California Archaeological Inventory and results of archival search in the state records on file with the California Archaeological Inventory
- ! background history of the area
- ! a copy of the USGS map showing the project area
- ! listing of known archaeological sites within a mile of the area, if relevant to the project
- ! an admonition regarding public distribution if information within the report reveals the location of archaeological/cultural resources or contains any other confidential information
- ! results of the surface reconnaissance of the subject property
- ! methodology of the archaeological study (surface survey, archival research)
- ! soil conditions in nearby locations
- ! bibliography regarding research in this area
- ! recommendation regarding stopping construction within a specified distance if evidence of a possible cultural or archaeological resource is found
- ! a clear statement/description regarding the need, if the need exists, for specified monitoring/spot checking of the site preparation/grading, etc.
- ! if a resource is found, a detailed list of recommendations for appropriate testing leading to development of appropriate mitigation measures (e.g. monitoring, time testing, data recovery, additional excavation, project modification, etc.)
